Life Among the “Godless” - For Sunday, March 10

Primary Passages:

Gen 26:1-33 (Isaac and Abimelek)

Gen 20: 1-18 (Abraham and Abimelek)

Jeremiah 29:4-7 (Israelites in Babylon)

John 17:13-18 (Christ’s prayer and commission of his disciples “in the world”)

1 John 4:16-19 (Departing Encouragement)

Questions:

Please do not just think about these questions, but take time to write your responses to them during the week, and consider sharing one or two with your group when you meet.

Read John 17:13-18. How does Christ’s prayer that you be “in the world” challenge the way you understand your role in Princeton?

Alternatively, how does his assumption that we are not “of the world” challenge the way you live in Princeton?

What promises or other resources in the John 17 passage that will make our success possible? Talk in your group about how we can live with this tension of being “in the world but not of the world.” How can you help each other as a group and as individuals pursue this calling?
