Claiming Your Inheritance - For Sunday, March 3

Primary Passages:

Genesis 25:19-34

Hebrews 12:4-17 - especially 15-17 regarding Esau

Questions:

Please do not just think about these questions, but take time to write your responses to them during the week, and consider sharing one or two with your group when you meet.

Read the passage from Hebrews. Consider that we, like Esau have an inheritance (or birthright) we are able to lay claim to through Jesus. What does it look like, according to the book of Hebrews, to lay claim to that birthright?

Those who accept Christ are “born again” and receive a new “birthright” through him. In Hebrews 12:15-17 we see sexual immorality listed as one of the “godless” acts causing the church to abandon this birthright. Now, considering the lyrics below from Lady Gaga’s “Born This Way”, discuss with your group how you might lovingly engage her lyrics from a Biblical perspective.
