

Life Group Questions

A Life of Obedience: Jacob and Esau continued. - For Sunday, April 14

Primary Passages:

Gen 32 and 33.

Matt. 13:44-46

Romans 1:5-6

Questions:

Please think about these questions and take time to write your responses to them during the week. Consider sharing one or two of your responses with your group when you meet.

Your story:

What experiences have influenced your feelings about obedience?

Does the thought of living in obedience to God excite you? If not, why not? If so, why so?

Reflection:

In Romans 1 5-6, Paul talks about the command he and the apostles were give to “call all the Gentiles to the *obedience that comes from faith* for his (Jesus’) name’s sake.” He then reminds the recipients of that letter, and us that “you also are among those Gentiles who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.”

- Reflect on Paul’s statement that “obedience comes from faith” it is a product of faith. What does your obedience say about your faith?

Prayer:

Share with your group areas you may struggle with obedience. It may be helpful to break apart as guys/girls for this time, or to set time aside to ask individuals privately during the week for support, prayer and accountability.
